Democracy	We have a proactive School Council. Representatives are elected by their class peers and they are involved in making Latchingdon a better place to learn. Pupil questionnaires and interviews are conducted throughout the year and responses are used to plan for improvement. Worship Group meets regularly with a member of the local church and HT, to plan whole school worship.	<b>Friendship</b> – Jesus tells stories of the heavenly banquet to which we are all invited. The barriers between people are broken down in a loving community around God. Jesus had stern words to say to those who refused to recognise that all are included in the community of friendship. <b>Courage</b> – faith and the love of God can give us the courage to take on challenges that we may find difficult.

The rule of law	<p>Pupils are taught what is right and wrong.</p> <p>There are school and class rules which are discussed and agreed by the children. They are regularly referred to by teachers and other staff.</p> <p>Rewards and sanctions are used consistently throughout the school, based on our rules.</p> <p>Pupils are taught the value and reasons behind laws, that they govern and protect us and that there are consequences when laws are broken.</p> <p>Visits from authorities such as the police, fire service, road safety etc. are regular parts of our calendar and help reinforce the message.</p>	<p><b>Hope</b> – <i>Every day is a new start no matter what you have done.</i></p> <p><i>The ten commandments.</i></p> <p><i>Ideas of forgiveness, redemption and salvation.</i></p> <p><b>Courage</b> – <i>it isn't always easy to stand up for what is right, e.g. Daniel in the Lion's Den.</i></p> <p><b>Forgiveness</b> – <i>as Christians we seek forgiveness for what we have done and forgive those who are sorry for what they have done.</i></p>
Individual liberty	<p>We teach children that we all have rights and responsibilities; that they must look after the school equipment, behave sensibly and take responsibility for their learning and behaviour.</p> <p>Pupils are given opportunities to make choices in their learning and at break-times e.g. singing up for extra-curricular clubs, choosing the level of challenge in some lessons and child-led activities in the Foundation Stage. They are given clear boundaries and re encouraged to think about the impact their actions have on others.</p>	<p><b>Forgiveness</b> – <i>The Fall – story of creation, shows us that at times we all do things that we know to be wrong and these can impinge on the rights of others.</i></p>
Mutual respect	<p>Adults and children treat people in school as they themselves would like to be treated. Whole school worship focusses on how we should behave towards others at school and in our wider society, regardless of race, culture, age or disability. Displays and posters around the building reinforce this.</p> <p>All staff are expected to provide good role models for pupils.</p>	<p><i>Our school vision encourages us to follow the command of Jesus who said: 'Love one another as I have loved you'</i></p> <p><b>Hope</b> – <i>people can always change for the better.</i></p> <p><b>Friendship</b> – <i>follow the example of Jesus who was a good friend – all those in need are our friend/neighbour.</i></p>
