

Maths Problem of the Week



KS1 (EYFS – Year 2)

The Problem

Mr Drake needs 20 metres of ribbon. Red ribbon costs £5 per metre.



Green ribbon costs £2 per metre.



He buys 12 metres of red ribbon. The rest is green.

How much does he spend in total?

KS2 (Year 3 – Year 6)

The Problem

Here is a rule for generating a sequence.

Multiply the previous term by 3 and subtract 4

The second term of the sequence is 5

Find the difference between the first and fourth terms of the sequence.




